Aurora	March 28	Music, piano, being outdoors, windy days. Favorite color: forest green.
Zander	May 6	BMX bikes and races. Favorite color: red and black.
Simon	May 15	Basketball, flags, blocks, stuffed animals. Favorite color: blue.
Brendan	June 16	Volleyball, science, space, STEM, video games, capybaras. Favorite color: blue.
Bethany	June 21	Baby dolls, color blue, being outside, socializing, cookies. Favorite color: blue.
Mikayla	July 11	Animals, mermaids, balloons, dancing, getting hair/nails done. Pink & purple.
Denys	July 20	Trains, animals, singing. Favorite color: green.
Anayah	Aug. 7	Cats, unicorns, games, music, books. Favorite color: pink
