- Use construction paper, markers, crayons, stickers, etc. Personalize cards with names and decorations. (No envelopes. No glitter.) Be creative!
- **Do NOT mention the child's diagnosis or challenges on the card.**
 - Yes : "Happy Valentine's Day!" "I like mermaids, too!"
 - No : "You're so brave." "I don't know how you do it." "I hope you get healed."
- If you make multiple cards, sort/clip them together by children's names. (ie, a stack for Alexis, a stack for Mikayla).
